The school is open from 7:30 a.m. until 6:30 p.m. to serve the schedules of working parents. Parents have the flexibility of setting their child's schedule. Breakfast, hot lunch and snack are served. Pacific Primary is open twelve months per year, with pre-established holidays and teacher preparation week. The school year begins in September. 2008-2009 annual tuition is \$16,766 (\$1,397 per month.) Tuition assistance is available depending on established need and availability of funds. Tuition assistance applications are due in early February. There is no tuition discount for a child's absence from school. Pacific Primary requires a commitment to the philosophy of the school, participation in parent meetings, maintenance projects, the annual auction, and other fundraising events each year.
